**TREE MANAGEMENT AND ARBORICULTURAL IMPACT**  
The rationale behind the approach to managing trees in the context of the proposed development is based on the findings of the Tree Survey report, the impact of the proposed development and the short to medium-term management needs of the trees on the site.  
The basis for the categorisation of trees on this Arboricultural Impact drawing are as follows:  
a. The identification for retention of trees which have the potential for medium to long-term contributions to the site and the surrounding environment (green outline).  
b. The removal of dead, dying or dangerous trees with a view to reducing hazardous specimens (red outline).  
c. Trees to be removed due to direct impact of the proposed development (magenta outline).
